AN ACT to legalize certain tax sales in the county of Chippewa.

## The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The sale of lands for the non-payment Sale of lands of taxes in the town of Eagle Point, in the county of Chippewa, by the treasurer of said county, in September, A. D. 1875. is hereby legalized and made valid to all intents and purposes, the same as if chapter 242, of the general laws of 1873, had not been enacted.
