Section 3. This act shall supersede and take the Act to superplace of all other acts and laws of this state, so far as cede otheracts, the same relates to the process and proceedings of selecting petit jurors in Marquette county.

Section 4. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after the first day of June, 1876.

CHAPTER 165.

[Published March 16, 1876.]

AN ACT conferring certain powers upon the town board of supervisors of the town of Bayfield, Bayfield county.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The board of supervisors of the town Authority of town board to of Bayfield are hereby authorized to construct sewers construct sew and drains along the public streets and alley-ways in ers and drains. the village of Bayfield, in the town of Bayfield, for the purpose of carrying waste water from public hydrants, and to provide proper sewerage for the village of Bayfield; provided, however, that at the annual town meeting, the electors of said town of Bayfield shall order the same done, and vote to raise a tax for the purpose named in this section.

Section 2. The town board of supervisors of the Authority to town of Bayfield are hereby authorized to annually levy special levy a tax sufficient to pay the Bayfield Hydraulic Company for the use of hydrants, and water used from the same, at fires; provided, however, that said tax shall not exceed one mill on the dollar valuation of the property of said town.

Section 3. This act shall take effect on and after its passage and publication.
