court of the United States for the eastern district of the State of Wisconsin, so far as the same relates to the taking of acknowledgments of deeds and other instruments, the administering of oaths and affirmations, and the taking of depositions, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid in all respects as if the same had been done or performed by any of the court commissioners of the circuit courts of this state.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
