SECTION 5. Instices of the peace now in office in said Present justicity of Milwaukee. shall hold their offices for and dur- in office. ing the term for which they have been elected and until their successors have qualified according to law.

Section 6. Each justice of the peace, now in office Officers to dein said city of Milwaukee, shall at the expiration of liver books, etc his term of office and after his successor in office shall have qualified according to law, deliver over to him all dockets, books and records in his possession, connected with his said office.

SECTION 7. Justices of the peace and constables of the peace and constables of take elected under the provisions of this act, shall give oath of office. bond and take the oath of office as now required by law.

Section 8. Chapter three hundred and thirty-two Repealed. of the laws of 1875, and all other acts and parts of acts which contravene the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

Section 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Cyrus Lanyon, a notary public of Iowa county.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The official acts of Cyrus Lanyon, a Acts logalized. notary public in Iowa county, are hereby declared to be lawful and valid, notwithstanding an intermission between the expiration of a former commission and the date of his present commission.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
