AN ACT to amend section three (3), of chapter one hundred and eighty-seven (187), of the revised statutes of the State of Wisconsin, entitled, "Of prisons generally and common jails."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

Charges to be paid from county treasnry.

Section 1. Section three (3), of chapter one hundred and eighty-seven (187), of the revised statutes of the State of Wisconsin, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 3. All charges for maintaining convicts who have been sentenced to confinement in the state prison, and the expense for maintaining persons charged with offenses and duly committed for trial, and of those who are confined in the county jail, or who may be committed for the non-payment of any fines, and expenses for safe keeping, shall be paid out of the county treasury, the accounts of the keeper of such jail having been first allowed by the board of county supervisors; provided, that such keeper shall be entitled to and shall receive such compensation for maintaining persons in said jail, as shall be allowed by the board of supervisors of the proper county, not less than three dollars (\$3) per week for each prisoner.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.
