All the acts and proceedings of joint Actslegalized. school district number one, in the towns of Royalton, Little Wolf and Mukwa, in Waupaca county, at the annual meetings thereof, held on the last Monday in August, in the years of 1873 and 1874, which were held on those days under a misapprehension of the law, instead of being held on the second Monday of July of said years, as the law required, the school in said district being a graded school, are hereby declared legal and valid to all intents and purposes.
