CHAPTER 35.

[Published February 19, 1876.]

AN ACT to authorize Charles Scofield, John Leatham, and Thomas H. Smith, to build and maintain a dock and pier in Sturgeon Bay.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorized to maintain dock and pier.

Section 1. Charles Scofield, John Leatham, and Thomas H. Smith, their successors, executors, heirs, or assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain a dock and pier, extending into Sturgeon Bay, from the eastern shore, from section six (6), beginning fifty feet north of the section line, upon the south line of said section six (6), in township twenty-seven (27) north, range twenty-six (26) east, Door county, running in a northwesterly direction, parallel with, and adjacent to, the usual steamboat channel, five hundred feet or more, as they may desire.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 36.

[Published February 19, 1876.]

AN ACT in relation to the boundaries of the town of Baldwin.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Addition of territory.

Section 1. The east half of the southeast quarter of section twenty-five (25), town twenty-nine (29), north, range seventeen (17) west, is hereby annexed to and made a part of the town of Baldwin, in St. Croix county.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
