CHAPTER 161.

AN ACT to amend an act to incorporate the State Fireman's Association of Wisconsin.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 484 of the private and local laws of 1866, is hereby amended by striking out the word "February," where it occurs in the second line of said section, and substituting in place thereof the word "September."

CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT to incorporate the city of New London.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

CHAPTER L

CITY AND WARD BOUNDARIES.

City boundaries. SECTION 1. All that section of country in section one (1), section twelve (12), section thirteen (13), township number twenty-two (22), in the county of Waupaca in this state, and the west half of section six (6), section seven (7), and the northwest quarter of section eighteen (18), in township number twenty-two (22), north of range number fifteen (15) east, in Outagamie county in this state shall hereafter be known and distinguished by the name of the city of New London, and the inhabitants residing, or who may hereafter reside within said limits, are hereby created and constituted a body corporate and politic, by the name and style of the city of New London, and by that name may have perpetual succession, and shall be capable of
