acting any of the business of the town of Plymouth at any place in the city of Plymouth, which may be designated by them for that purpose, and for the transaction of any business to be transacted by said town board or by said supervisors; but said board shall first give notice as provided in section two of this act, of the place so designated by them for the transaction of such business.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and fifty-seven of the laws of Wisconsin for 1877, entitled An act relating to the dam on Little Wolf river, in Waupaca county, and amendatory of section four of chapter one hundred and sixty-nine of the laws of Wisconsin for 1875.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows.

Re-enacted.

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and fifty-seven of the laws of Wisconsin for 1877, entitled an act relating to a dam on Little Wolf River in Waupaca county, and amendatory of section four of chapter one hundred and sixty-nine of the laws of Wisconsin for 1875, is hereby repealed; and the provisions of section four of chapter one hundred and fifty-nine of the laws of Wisconsin for 1873 are hereby restored and in force.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
