CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT to legalize the actions of joint school district number twelve (12), of the towns of Berlin and Nepeuskun, in the counties of Green Lake and Winnebago.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All the acts of joint school district Acts legalized. number twelve (12) of the towns of Berlin and Nepeuskun, in the counties of Green Lake and Winnebago, state of Wisconsin, at a school district meeting, held in said district on the first Monday in September, 1877 (instead of the last Monday in August, as the law directs), are hereby declared legal and valid, and the officers elected thereat are hereby declared to be the legal officers thereof, anything to the contrary notwithstanding; and all official acts of the officers elected at said meeting above mentioned shall be held to be as legal and binding as though they had been elected at the regular annual meeting of said district.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 22.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Manitowoc County Central Agricultural Society, a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of Appropriation. any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred dollars, for the benefit of the Manitowoc County Central Agricultural Society for the year 1876.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
