CHAPTER 23.

AN ACT to legalize the annual meetings of school districts in town of Lakeland, Barron county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Acts legalized. SECTION 1. All the business transacted in the several school districts in the town of Lakeland, Barron county, at their annual meetings, held on the last Monday of August in each year, 1876 and 1877, is hereby declared as legal, for all purposes, as though the said meetings had been held on the last Monday of September, or a copy of the proceeding of said districts changing the time for holding the annual meeting, as provided by law, had been filed with the town clerk of said town.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Milwaukee to refund the cost of grading and paving certain gutters in 1874.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority of common council. SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Milwaukee is hereby authorized to refund to all persons, who have heretofore paid, or may hereafter pay any sum of money on account of the grading and paving of the gutters on Third street, between Cherry and Harmon streets in the sixth ward of said city, in the year 1874, the sum and sums of money so paid or to be paid by such persons respectively. Any and all sums refunded under this act shall be charged to and paid out of the ward fund of the sixth ward of said city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
