CHAPTER 342.

AN ACT to grant leave of absence to chief geologist Chamberlain for the period and purposes therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Leave of absence granted.

SECTION 1. Leave of absence is hereby granted to chief geologist, T. C. Chamberlain, during the months of June, July and August A. D. 1878, with continuance of salary, for the purpose of attending the international convention of geologists at Paris, and also for the purpose of taking charge, during the period above named, of the educational and geological exhibits at the world's exposition at Paris.

SECTION 2 This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.
