CHAPTER 79.

AN ACT to repeal chapter two hundred and fifty of the general laws of 1875, entitled, "an act to provide for the free and unobstructed navigation of the west branch of the Kickapoo river, between certain points therein named."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and fifty of the general laws of 1875, entitled, "an act to provide for the free and unobstructed navigation of the Kickapoo river between certain points therein designated," is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of all town insurance companies of the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The proceedings of all town insurance companies in the state of Wisconsin, held on the 1st day of January, 1878, are hereby declared legal and valid to all intents and purposes, and in all places, as though the same had been held at the time provided by law, except so far as the same proceedings may affect the exclusion of members or the cancellation of policies. Legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
