CHAPTER 139.

AN ACT to repeal chapter ninety-three of the general laws of 1872, relating to the improvement in the capitol park.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter ninety-three of the general laws of 1872, entitled "An act to provide for provide for improvement of the capitol park," is hereby repealed. Repealed.

CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-seven, laws of Wisconsin of 1879, to provide for the election of justices of the peace in the city of Watertown.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter sixty-seven of the laws of Wisconsin of 1879, is hereby amended by striking out the words "Tuesday succeeding the first Monday" and inserting in their place "first Tuesday." Amended.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 141.

AN ACT to amend section one hundred and twenty-one, chapter ten, revised statutes 1878, in relation to distribution of Blue Books.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one hundred and twenty one, chapter ten, revised statutes of 1878, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The secretary of state shall cause to be printed four thousand copies of such Number of blue books; distribution.
