CHAPTER 219.

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter twenty-two of the general laws of 1879, entitled “an act to facilitate the execution of the trusts assumed by the state of Wisconsin by her acceptance of the grants of land made by acts of congress, approved respectively June 3d, 1856, and May 5th, 1864, to aid in the construction of certain railroads in said state.”

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter twenty-two of the general laws of 1879, entitled “an act to facilitate the execution of the trusts assumed by the state of Wisconsin by her acceptance of the grants of land made by acts of congress approved respectively June 3, 1856, and May 5th, 1864, to aid in the construction of certain railroads in said state,” is hereby amended by striking out the word “each,” where the same occurs before the word “county,” in the last line of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word “such.”

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 220.

AN ACT to authorize the issuing of patents to deceased persons in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. In all cases where patents for lands belonging to the state of Wisconsin have been or may hereafter be issued in pursuance of any law of this state, to a person who had died, or who shall hereafter die, before the date of such patent, the title to the land

Title to vest in heirs.
