## CHAPTER 253.

AN ACT to appropriate to Winnebago county a sum of money therein named.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Winnebago county, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five hundred and thirty-two dollars and twelve cents, said amount having been paid by said county for the support of James Regau and Kate Kallager, two insane persons who are not residents of said county, and are properly chargeable to the state. Appropriation, \$332.12.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 254.

AN ACT to repeal sections one thousand six hundred and twenty-six, one thousand six hundred and twenty-seven, one thousand six hundred and twenty-eight, and one thousand six hundred and thirty, of chapter seventy-two of the revised statutes, entitled "of wild animals."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Sections one thousand six hundred and twenty-six, one thousand six hundred and twenty-seven, one thousand six hundred and twenty-eight and one thousand six hundred and thirty, of chapter seventy-two of the revised statutes, entitled "of wild animals," are hereby repealed. Bounty on scalps of wild animals, repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
