### CHAPTER 166.

AN ACT authorizing the city of Racine to purchase additional cemetery grounds.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city of Racine is hereby authorized to purchase additional lands for cemetery purposes, at such price as the council and the owners of such lands may agree upon. When the terms of such purchase shall have been agreed upon between the common council and such owners, the mayor and city clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the city, all necessary contracts, obligations and papers for the purchase of said lands in accordance with the terms so agreed upon. Said common council shall so provide that such per centage of the sums arising from sales of lots in said cemetery grounds as it may deem sufficient for the purpose, shall be kept and reserved by the city treasurer, in a separate fund, not to be drawn upon except for the purpose of paying the installments of purchase money of said lands, as they fall due, until said purchase money be fully paid. In case the sums so reserved prove insufficient to pay said purchase money, the general cemetery funds of the city may be used for that purpose, but no other funds of the city shall be drawn upon.
