CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT to amend section six hundred and seventy of the revised statutes, relating to special powers of the county board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Dock and wharf lines. SECTION 1. Section six hundred and seventy of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto subdivision twelve, which shall read as follows, to-wit: 12. To establish dock or wharf lines upon navigable waters in counties wherein there is no incorporated city or village; but such county board shall not have power to alter or discontinue such dock or wharf lines.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 208.

AN ACT relating to the duties of clerks of the board of public works of the city of Milwakee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Duty of clerk of board.

SECTION 1. It is hereby made the duty of any clerk of the board of public works of the city of Milwaukee to perform such service as the said board may by its rules prescribe; and when said board shall require any such clerk to sign or certify to an official document issued by said board, his signature shall have the same force and effect as the signature of the secretary.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
