## CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT relating to and amendatory of subdivision 2 of section 2, chapter 150, general laws of 1881, entitled an act for the payment of bounty on wild animals.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subdivision 2, section 2, chapter 150, <sup>Wild animals.</sup> general laws of 1881, is hereby amended by adding after the figures "18—," where they appear in the eleventh line of said section, the words, "and that the scalp of said — was removed in my presence," so that said subdivision, when so amended, shall read as follows: "I, — —, chairman of said town in said county, do certify that — —, has this day exhibited to me the carcass of a —, which he claims to have killed in said town on the — day of —, 18—, and that the scalp of said — was removed in my presence.

## CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT to authorize the county board of Columbia county to appropriate aid to rebuild bridges washed away by the overflow of the Wisconsin river.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors of the county <sup>May appropriate money.</sup> of Columbia is hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate such an amount of money as in the judgment of said board shall be deemed necessary to repair or rebuild any bridge or bridges washed away or damaged in said Columbia county by reason of the overflow of the Wisconsin river and other rivers and streams in said Columbia county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
