## CHAPTER 324.

AN ACT to authorize the town and village of Fremont, in Waupaca county, to build a bridge across Wolf river.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The town and village of Fremont, Waupaca county, are hereby authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a bridge across Wolf river, at the village of Fremont, connecting the highway heretofore laid out to the west bank of said river at the foot of Main street of said village, with the highway laid out to the east bank of said river opposite their respective termini.

Authorized to build a bridge.

SECTION 2. Said bridge shall be built of such material, and of such size and dimensions, and such plans, as the board of supervisors of said town, and village board of said village, may direct. Said bridge shall be built at least three (3) feet above high water mark, and shall be a safe, permanent and durable bridge for the accommodation of the traveling public.

SECTION 3. Said bridge shall be built with a turn table with a span of fifty (50) feet on each side thereof. Said turn table shall be built so as not to prevent the running of logs, lumber or rafts; shall be opened and closed for all steamboats and barges that may navigate said river, and at the expense of said town and village of Fremont.

How built.

SECTION 4. Nothing in this act contained shall be construed as granting any privileges conflicting with rights heretofore acquired under any previous laws of this state.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
