CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT relating to highways and amendatory of subdivision 2, of section 1223, of chapter 52, of the revised statutes, entitled, "of highways and bridges."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Subdivision 2, of section 1223, of chapter 52, of the revised statutes of 1878, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "2. To cause all legal highways, not fully and sufficiently described or recorded, and such of the roads used as highways, as have been laid out, but not fully and sufficiently described or recorded, to be ascertained, described and entered of record in the town clerk's office."
