Lake, on the first Tuesday in April next, and shall elect the various town officers as is now prescribed by law.

SECTION 4. After said election shall have been when the town held as provided by this act, and the officers that ised may be elected thereat, shall have duly qualified according to law, the said town of Rib Lake shall be deemed to be duly organized, and shall possess all the rights and privileges of other towns of this state.

SECTION 5. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 249.

AN ACT to legalize the acts of the village board of the village of Sauk City, in the county of Sauk, in the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The acts of all village boards which Acts legalized issued bridge bonds in the year 1882, are hereby legalized in all things pertaining to the issuance of such bonds.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 3, 1885.
