CHAPTER 255.

AN ACT to authorize Carl J. Berg and Nils A. Madson to construct and maintain a dam across the Embarrass river in Shawano county, for hydraulic and manufacturing purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorized to construct a dam.

Section 1. Carl J. Berg and Nils A. Madson, or their assigns, are hereby authorized to construct and maintain a dam across the middle branch of the Embarrass river in the county of Shawano, on lands owned by the said Carl J. Berg and Nils A. Madson and described as follows: The northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section number twenty-three, township number twentyseven, range number twelve east; said dam to be constructed for hydraulic and manufacturing purposes, and for the purpose of facilitating the driving of logs and timber down said stream. Said dam may be built to a sufficient height to raise a head of water not to exceed twelve feet above low water mark. Provided, that said dam shall not interfere with the rights of any person heretofore acquired. The aforesaid persons, their successors or assigns, shall build suitable slides in said dam for the running of logs, timber and lumber over the same, and shall keep the same in repair; and provided also, that the legislature reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act whenever in its judgment the public interest should so reauire.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
