CHAPTER 256.

AN ACT relating to corporations, and to repeal chapter 143, of the general laws of 1881.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 143, of the general laws of Respecting the 81 is hereby repealed; and subdivision 2 of sec-1881, is hereby repealed; and subdivision 2, of section 1772, of the revised statutes, is restored, and shall remain as before said act was passed. No corporate name shall be held illegal because of the omission of the word, "limited."
