The superintendent of public property is hereby authorized and directed to pure erty authorized chase six hundred copies, which number shall into clude those copies now furnished the legislature, revised status of Caphana and Panaman's supplement to the of Sanborn and Berryman's supplement to the revised statutes of Wisconsin, to supply the offices, officers and institutions named herein, viz.: One copy for each circuit judge, one copy for each judge of the United States courts resident within this state; one copy for each judge of every other court of record; one copy for each county officer in the state, except county surveyors and coroners, county superintendent and county treasurer, and such other copies as may be needed for the state officers and state institutions; and to the state librarian one copy of such publication for exchange with each of the several states and territories which practice like comity with this state; the remaining copies shall be held by the superintendent of public property, for the use of the legislature; provided, that said supplements shall be printed on good quality of book paper, and be bound in good law sheep; and, provided, further, that they shall be delivered to the said superintendent, at the capitol, at a price not to exceed five dollars per copy.

CHAPTER 270.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1878, entitled, "An act to authorize the board of supervisors of Milwaukee county to borrow a sum of money therein stated.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 307, of the laws of Wisconsin for the year 1878, is hereby wave county to berrow sum of money. The ninth line of said section the words, "state," in the ninth line of said section the words, "or to meet the current expenses of the county, or for any other purpose which said county board may deem necessary," so that the said section, as so amended shall read as follows: "Section 1. board of supervisors of Milwaukee county is hereby authorized and empowered to borrow and appropriate a sum of money not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, in addition to all sums of money said county is now authorized to borrow and appropriate under any local or general law of this state, for the purpose of constructing any additional county buildings required or permitted under the laws of this state, or to meet the current expenses of the county, or for any other purpose which said county board may deem necessary. Said money may be borrowed by the issue of bonds, or by a note signed in behalf of the county by the chairman of the board and the
