CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT to amend section 2424, of the revised statutes, and to provide for the terms of the circuit court in the seventh judicial circuit, and to provide for special terms therein.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That so much of section 2424, of the revised statutes as related to the terms of the circuit court in the seventh judicial circuit be, and the same is amended so as to read as follows :

SEVENTH CIRCUIT.

Time for holding court and last Monday in October.

In the county of Marathon, third Monday in March and second Monday in November.

In the county of Portage, fourth Monday in February and first Monday in October.

In the county of Price, last Monday in January and last Monday in June.

In the county of Taylor, second Monday in February and first Monday in July.

In the county of Wavpaca, second Monday in June and first Monday in January.

In the county of Waushara, third Tuesday in April and last Tuesday in September.

In the county of Wood, fourth Monday in May and first Monday in December.

Every general term in the seventh judicial circuit shall also be a special term for the whole circuit.

SECTION 2. All writs, summons, recognizances, process, informations, motions and other proceedings in said several courts in the seventh judicial circuit, and all jurors summoned to attend and all notices of trial, and every and all proceedings pending or to be heard on the days heretofore fixed as the first days of the several terms in said circuit, shall be held returnable, cited to appear, and noticed for hearing on the day herein fixed for the first day of said several terms, and shall be heard and disposed of, as if notice for hearing on the days herein fixed.

SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with this act are hereby repealed so far as they conflict with this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved February 3, 1885.
