of this act to comply with the provisions of this chapter, shall be held and deemed a surrender of all privileges and rights conferred upon the Black River Improvement Company by any law of this state."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 4, 1885.

CHAPTER 317.

AN ACT to repeal an act of the laws of 1848, entitled, "an act to authorize the construction of a dam across Crawfish river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repealed.

Section 1. Whereas, George Bleeker and others, by a warranty deed recorded in the register's office of Jefferson county, Wisconsin, in volume 85 of deeds, on page 122, etc., have become the sole owners of the hereinafter mentioned dam; and, whereas, the said owners are desirous to have the act, authorizing the construction of said dam repealed, therefore, an act of the laws of 1848, entitled, "An act to authorize the construction of a dam across the Crawfish river," and authorizing and empowering Norman Pratt and his associates and assigns, to build and maintain a dam across Crawfish river in the county of Jefferson, on any land owned by them, on section four, town seven, north of range fourteen east, sufficient to create a head of not exceeding six feet, and to make use of said water for hydraulic purposes, approved August 18, 1848, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
