CHAPTER 318.

AN ACT to authorize the county of Eau Claire to construct and maintain a free wagon bridge over and across the Chippewa river, between the towns of Brunswick and Union in said county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The county of Eau Claire, and its successors and assigns, is hereby authorized to construct and maintain a free wagon bridge over and across the Chippewa river, between the towns of Brunswick and Union, on sections twenty-six and thirty-five, in township twenty-seven north, of range ten west, in said county, and for such purpose may erect piers, drive piles and build embankments and approaches in said Chippewa river and on the banks thereof, necessary for the proper and convenient construction and maintenance of said bridge; provided, that a suitable draw be built and maintained in said bridge for the passage of boats, and that said bridge be so constructed as not to materially interfere with the free navigation of said river or the running of rafts, logs, timber or lumber down the same; and provided further, that said bridge shall be constructed according to plans approved by the secretary of war of the United States or of such engineer as he shall designate.

City authorized to construct a free wagon bridge over Chippewa river.

SECTION 2. The county board of supervisors of said county is hereby authorized, upon the plans for said bridge being approved as required by section 1, of this act, to provide for the building and maintenance thereof, as a county bridge.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
