CHAPTER 325.

AN ACT to cede to the United States the jurisdiction of the state of Wisconsin over certain lands in the city of La Crosse for the purpose of erecting thereon, a public building for the use of the United States.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The jurisdiction of the state of Lands coded to Wisconsin over such tract or parcel of land situate states for the in the city of La Crosse, in the county of La Crosse public building and state of Wisconsin, not exceeding two acres, thereon. as shall be acquired and purchased by the United States, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining thereon a public building for the use of the United States, is hereby ceded to the United States of America and shall be forever free from taxation by and under the laws of this state while the United States shall hold the title thereof; provided, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to interfere with or prevent the service of process issued out of any of the courts of this state, upon said tract of land, or to interfere in any way with the jurisdiction of this state to punish crimes and offenses against the laws of this state committed thereon.

Section 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
