## CHAPTER 327.

AN ACT to amend sections 447 and 449, of chapter 27, of the revised statutes, entitled, "of common schools."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Provision shall be made by the prophysiology and per local school authorities for instructing all pupils in all schools supported by public money, or under state control, in physiology and hygiene, with special reference to the effects of stimulants and narcotics upon the human system.

SECTION 2. The text-books used in giving the foregoing instruction shall receive the joint approval of the state superintendent of public instruction, and the state board of health.

SECTION 3. No certificate shall be granted to any person to teach in the public schools of Wisconsin, after the first day of January, 1886, who has not passed a satisfactory examination in physiology and hygiene, with special reference to the effects of stimulants and narcotics upon the human system.

SECTION 4. All acts and parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 7, 1885.
