Section 1164, of the revised statutes, Respecting the is hereby amended by adding thereto the follow-unlawful taxes. ing words: "Provided, however, that no action shall be maintained under the provisions of this section, unless it shall be made to appear to the court, that the plaintiff has paid more than his equitable share of such taxes.

CHAPTER 342.

AN ACT to prevent the manufacture, sale or transportation of explosives intended for the criminal destruction of life or property.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person who makes, manufac-criminal detures, compounds, buys, sells or gives away, offers life or properto give away, transports or has in his possession, ty, remains for same. any nitro-glycerine, giant powder, oriental powder, thunderbolt powder, dynamite, ballastile, fulgarite, detonite or any other explosive compound, with intent that any of such explosive compound shall be used at any place within this state, or any state of the United States, or any foreign country, for the injury or destruction of public or private property, or the assassination or murder, injury or destruction of any person or persons, either within this state, or any state of the United States, or
