## CHAPTER 363.

AN ACT to authorize the building of a dam across the Sheboygan river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorized to build a dam.

SECTION 1. Henry Huson, his associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to maintain a dam, not exceeding ten feet in height, across the Sheboygan river, on the southeast quarter of section thirteen, township sixteen north, range twenty east, for the purpose of restoring the river to its original channel; provided, nothing in this act shall interfere with the rights of any person heretofore required, and reserving the right to the legislature to alter or amend this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
