maintain a dam across the Plover river, on lands owned by said H. M. Wadleigh, in the county of Marathon, described as the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section number nineteen, in township number twenty-eight north, of range number ten east, in Marathon county, Wisconsin, for the purpose of holding logs. The aforesaid person, his associates or assigns, shall build suitable slides in said dam for the running of logs, timber and lumber over the same, and shall keep the same in repair.

SECTION 2. The right to alter, amend or repeal this act is hereby reserved.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 11, 1885.

CHAPTER 413.

AN ACT appropriating money for the purchase of stationery for the use of the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Appropriation for stationery for state. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of six thousand dollars, for the purchase of stationery for the use of state officers and departments for the years 1885 and 1886, and for the legislative session of 1887; said sum being the amount estimated to be necessary for the purpose specified.

SECTION 2. Any balance of appropriations heretofore made for the purchase of stationery unexpended at the time of the passage and publication of this act is hereby covered into the state treasury.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 11, 1885.
