CHAPTER 64.

AN ACT relating to the collection of statistics and amendatory of section 1007, of the revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Relating to the sale of land.

Section 1007, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words: In such statement the sales shall be classified so as to show those in each section and in each town, city or village separately; and the county clerk shall cause an abstract of such statement showing the total number of acres and of platted lots in each town, city or village so sold, with the consideration and the assessed value in total, to be printed and laid before the county board at its annual session in November in each year.
