

four years, a tax of not more than seven mills on the dollar, upon all the taxable property of said city, which tax shall be levied and collected as general city taxes of said city are, and shall be applied to the payment of said bonds and the accrued interest thereon.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 7.

AN ACT relating to teachers' institutes, and amendatory of section 408, of the revised statutes, making appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section 408, of chapter 26, of the revised statutes, is amended by inserting after the words "general fund," in the fifth line, the following: "And the state superintendent may use

such additional sum, not exceeding one thousand dollars, to be also paid from the general fund, as he shall deem proper, for the purpose of providing public lectures in connection with such institutes, by the professor of the theory and art of teaching of the university;" so that said section, when amended, shall read as follows: "Section 408. For the purpose mentioned in the preceding section, the said board may use such sum, not exceeding seven thousand dollars in any year, as it may deem necessary, of which not exceeding five thousand dollars shall be paid from the Normal school fund income, and not exceeding two thousand dollars from the general fund, and the state superintendent may use such additional sum, not exceeding one thousand dollars, to be also paid from the general fund, as he shall deem proper, for the purpose of providing public lectures in connection with such institutes, by the professor of the theory and art of teaching of the university, and such amounts as shall be so expended are hereby annually appropriated from the said funds respectively."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

CHAPTER 8.

AN ACT to authorize school district number one, town of Dodgeville, Iowa county, to borrow money from the trust funds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. School district number one, of the town of Dodgeville, Iowa county, is hereby authorized to borrow from the trust funds, and the commissioners of public lands are hereby authorized to loan to said school district upon certificates of indebtedness, to be signed by the officers of said district, the sum of three thousand dollars to draw interest, at the rate of seven per cent. per annum to be paid annually in advance, and the
