## CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT to authorize the state board of supervision to purchase a tract of land and a building adjoining the state hospital.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Board of supervision may purchase certain tract of land adjoining state hospital.

SECTION 1. The state board of supervision is hereby authorized, at their discretion, to purchase, for the state, a tract of land about five acres in extent, adjoining the grounds of the state hospital, and also to purchase a small frame building situated on the grounds of the state hospital, and now claimed to be owned by one Frank Doyle.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
