fifty dollars, or to be imprisoned in the jail of such county not more than thirty days nor less than ten days at the direction of the court, and the license held by such person shall be forfeited and void.

SECTION 17. All publications required by this Publication. act to be published in any newspaper, shall be so published under the laws of this state in some newspaper published in said city of Pittsville, if any there be, and the compensation to be paid therefor shall, in all cases (unless otherwise contracted by the common council, be at the rates established and prescribed by the laws of this state.

SECTION 18. This act is hereby declared to be Public act. a public act, and shall be liberally construed in

all courts of this state.

SECTION 19. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication. Approved March 30, 1887.

## CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT to amend chapter 159, laws of 1885, entitled, "an act to revise, codify and amend chapter 278, laws of 1874," entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Shawano, and several acts amendatory thereof."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 10, of chapter 6, of chapter Regarding the 159, laws of 1885, is hereby amended by striking levy. out the words, "the percentage named in this act" and inserting the words, "four mills per dollar on the assessed valuation," so that the same shall read, when amended, as follows: Annually upon the receipt of notice from the county clerk of Shawano county of the amount of taxes apportioned to said city by the county board of supervisors, the common council, as soon as practicable

thereafter, shall, by resolution, levy the amount of taxes apportioned to said city by the county board, and in addition levy such tax or taxes authorized by law not exceeding four mills per dollar on the assessed valuation, for city purposes, and all special taxes as may be sufficient for the several purposes for which taxes are herein authorized to be levied, particularly specifying in the resolution the purposes for which the same are levied.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 205.

AN ACT to amend charter of city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Term of alderman.

SECTION 1. Each of the several wards of the city of Milwaukee shall hereafter be represented in the common council by two aldermen. The term of office of the aldermen hereafter elected shall be two years. The common council of the city of Milwaukee shall hereafter be composed of two aldermen from each ward.

Terms of aldermen.

SECTION 2. No alderman shall be elected at the annual election in April, 1887, in any ward of said city, except in wards which shall not at the time of holding such elections, have two members of the board of aldermen, whose terms of office respectively continue one and two years from the third Tuesday in April, 1887. In all such wards, if any there be, there shall be elected at the next annual municipal election, one or two aldermen, as may be necessary to give such ward two members of the board of aldermen, whose term of office shall respectively expire one and two years after the third Tuesday in April, 1887.
