Tuesday in April, 1887, and said election shall not be held previous to said third Tuesday of April, 1887.

Terms of office.

28. SECTION 2. The terms of all officers of said city are hereby extended until said third Tuesday in April, 1887, and until their successors are elected or appointed and have qualified.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 1, 1887.

## CHAPTER 225.

AN ACT extending the time for holding the first charter election in the city of Durand, from the first Tuesday in April, 1887, to the second Tuesday in April, 1887.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Extending time for holding charter election in city of Durand.

SECTION 1. The time for holding the first charter election in the city of Durand, is hereby extended from the first Tuesday in April, 1887, to the second Tuesday in April, 1887.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 1, 1887.
