CHAPTER 265.

AN ACT to facilitate the laying out of a highway through certain lands of the Wisconsin Industrial School for boys, at Waukesha.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorizing state board of supervision to lay out high-way.

Section 1. The state board of supervision of Wisconsin charitable, reformatory and penal institutions, is hereby authorized and empowered, on the part of the state of Wisconsin, upon such terms and conditions, and for such considerations, as to them may appear reasonable and proper, to give consent to the laying out, by the proper authorities, of a public highway through the farm lands of said state connected with the Wisconsin Industrial School for boys, at Waukesha, Wisconsin, and upon agreement between such authorities and said board as to the lands so to be taken and the compensation to be paid therefor, if any, the president of said board is hereby empowered on behalf of the state to execute all proper releases of the lands so taken for the purposes of such highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
