CHAPTER 284.

AN ACT to provide for the purchase of an additional number of blue books, for the year 1887, and to appropriate money therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation for purchase of additional cop es of blue book, 1887.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated a sum of money sufficient to pay for the blue books ordered to be printed and distribted under joint resolution No. 16, senate not exceeding however the sum of one dollar and ten cents per copy for such books, and the secretary of state is hereby authorized to furnish such blue books and distribute the same as soon as possible after the passage of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
