CHAPTER 323.

AN ACT relating to the record of deeds and other instruments for the conveyance of land.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

What, sufficient deeds, etc.

Section 1. In all cases where, in entering for reference to record any deed or other instrument of conveyance of land in any index required by law to be kept in the office of any register of deeds in this state, any register has entered, in the indexcolumn provided for describing the land affected by such deed or other instrument the words "see record," or "see deed," or "see mortgage," or other instrument, as the case may be, such entry shall be held a sufficient reference to the record at large of such deed or other instrument, if the same be in fact recorded at large in the place referred to in such index.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 2, 1887.
