CHAPTER 399.

AN ACT to amend chapter XI, of chapter 252, of the laws of 1887, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Durand."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter XI, of chapter 252, laws of 1887, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Durand," is hereby amended by adding to the end of said chapter XI, the following new sections:

Equitable settlement. Section 20. It is hereby made the duty of the common council of said city and the board of supervision of said town of Durand to meet together at some convenient place on or before the first Monday of May, 1887, upon notice given by either body, and if possible agree upon some just, fair and equitable settlement or adjustment and
