CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT to amend section 772, chapter 37, revised statutes of 1878, relating to fees of county surveyors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 772, of chapter \$7, of the Amending secrevised statutes, is hereby amended by adding after the word, "dollars," where it occurs in the second subdivision of said section, the following: Provided, however, that the county boards of the several counties in the state may, at any annual meeting, fix the per diem to be paid at a greater sum, not to exceed five dollars.
