join with the municipalities of Michigan to construct and maintain a bridge over the Menominee River and to levy taxes and borrow money in aid thereof," is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 475.

AN ACT relating to the distribution, in Burnett county, of the five per centum of gross earnings of the North Wisconsin Railway Company, apportioned to said county under the provisions of chapter 22, of the laws of 1879.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The county treasurer of Burnett Apportionment county shall annually apportion the amount which of mount residence and county shall receive under the provisions of North Wisconchapter 22, of the laws of 1879, to the several sin Railway—towns of said county, upon towns of the value Burnet county. ation of said towns as determined by the last preceding county assessment.
