CHAPTER 505.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of clerks, experts, stenographer and witnesses authorized under the provisions of joint resolution. No. 21, S.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation §725 to pay expense of investigating committee.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated a sum of money not to exceed seven hundred and twenty-five dollars, for the payment of clerk hire, experts, witnesses and other necessary expenses of the committee appointed under the provisions of joint resolution No. 21 S.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 506.

AN ACT to amend section 2433, chapter 113, revised statutes, entitled, of the circuit courts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amending section 2488, R. S., court commissioner, Eau Claire county.

SECTION 1. Section 2453, of the revised statutes of Wisconsin for the year 1878, is hereby amended by striking out the word, "and," in the last line thereof, and inserting the words, "Eau Claire," after the word, "Rock," in said last line thereof, so that said section when amended shall read as follows: Section 2433. The circuit courts, and the circuit judges in vacation, may appoint in each of the counties in their respective circuits,
