CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT to authorize justices of the peace elected in the several wards of the city of Baraboo to keep an office and perform their duties in any part of said city.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The justices of the peace elected in the several wards of the city of Baraboo may keep their offices and perform all the duties pertaining thereto in any part of said city, as fully as they now do in the wards in which they were respectively elected.

Justices of peace may hold office in any part of city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 66.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the city of Beloit to construct and maintain a bridge across Rock river, in the city of Beloit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Beloit is hereby authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a bridge across Rock river, above the dam in said city, between the Second and Third wards.

May construct bridge across Rock river.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
