## CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Chippewa Falls to issue bonds for the purpose of paying its indebtedness.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

City authorized to issue bonds to pay indebtedness.

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Chippewa Falls, in the state of Wisconsin, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds to the amount of sixteen thousand dollars, for the purpose of paying outstanding indebtedness. That said bonds, when issued, shall be signed by the mayor and city clerk of said city, and shall be issued only when authorized by a vote of a majority of the common council, they shall draw interest at a rate not exceeding five per centum per annum, payable annually at the office of the city treasurer in said city; and said bonds shall become due at the option of said common council in not less than five years and not more than twenty years, and none of said bonds shall be sold for less than par value.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to fix terms of circuit court in fourteenth circuit.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Fixing terms of court in 14th judicial circuit.

SECTION 1. The general terms of the circuit court for the fourteenth judicial circuit shall be

held as follows: In the county of Door, the first Tuesday in February and the Tuesday after the first Monday in September; in the county of Marinette, the first Monday of October, the second Monday of January and the first Monday of May; in the county of Oconto, the second Monday of April and the second Monday of November; in the county of Brown, the fourth Monday of November, the first Monday of March and the first Monday of June. Every term in the counties of Brown, Oconto and Marinette shall also be a special term for the whole judicial circuit.

SECTION 2. The jurors for each term of court shall be summoned to appear at or before the hour of nine o'clock A. M. on the second day of the term.

Jurors, when to appear in Brown, Oconto and Marinette counties.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1887.

## CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to appropriate the sums of money therein named to the charitable, reformatory and penal institutions of the state.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, to the institutions below named, the following sums of money, for the purposes specified, to-wit: To the Wisconsin state hospital for the insane for current expenses, including painting and necessary repairs, to January 1, 1889, one hundred and fifteen thousand dollars. To the northern hospital for the insane for current expenses, including painting and necessary repairs, to January 1, 1889, one hundred and thirty-one thousand dollars. To the Wisconsin school
