## CHAPTER 99.

AN ACT relating to the taking and carrying away by a trespass of things annexed to the reality.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person who by a trespass, with Penalty for tak intent to steal, takes and carries away anything ing and carrying away things which is parcel of the realty or annexed thereto, annexed to realty. the property of another and of some value, against the will of the owner, shall be guilty of such larceny as he would be guilty of if such property were personal property, and the same court shall have jurisdiction of offenses under this section as would have jurisdiction if the property stolen were personal property.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
