JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1.

Requesting the governor to place an elevater in the south wing of the capitol.

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring: That the governor be and he is hereby requested and directed to have placed in the south wing of the capitol building, a passenger elevator.

JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2.

For the distribution of additional copies of the Blue Book.

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring: That the secretary of state is hereby directed to order from the state printer additional copies of the Blue Book for 1887, at a cost not to exceed the price per copy of the first edition, after all charges for type setting have been deducted therefrom, to be delivered to him and distributed by him as follows: Fifty copies each to the governor, lieutenant-gov. ernor, secretary of state, state treasurer, attorney general, superintendent of public instruction, railway commissioner, commissioner of insurance, to each member of the legislature, and to the chief clerks and sergeant-at-arms thereof; one for each school district in the state, and one for every distinct department of every school district in the several towns, cities and villages in the state, to be kept for the use of such schools, to be delivered through the office of the superintendent of public instruction under such restrictions as he may impose.
