## CHAPTER 18.

AN ACT relating to county officers and amendatory of section 756, of the revised statutes, entitled, "of county officers."

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 756, of the revised statutes, Amending see entitled, "of county officers," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 756. Every register of deeds shall appoint one or more deputies who shall hold their office during his pleasure. Such appointment shall be in writing, and filed and recorded in his office. Such deputy or deputies shall aid the register in the performance of his duties under his direction, and in case of vacancy or the register's absence or inability to perform the duties of his office, such deputy or deputies shall perform the duties of register during the continuance of such vacancy, absence or inability, and the register shall be responsible on his official bond for the faithful performance by such deputy or deputies of all his duties aforesaid.

SECTION 2. This art shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved February 23, 1889.
